- **Bench Project:** We are awaiting sites for the benches before going to the donors. They will be given choices of the location based on when they sent in the funds. Delivery of benches is expected in May and the installation is set for June.
- Building Book: A number of copies have been sent out on consignment.
- **Garden tours:** Rob Information for eight tours has been given to Shelley so it can be posted on the website. Registration is on-line. Tour guides to be assigned.
- **Woodland improvement:** Eric AAFC is purchasing some plants and growing others. FCEF will purchase some smaller plants and assist with planting and watering.
