### PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Eric

- New office staff member Aline Michaud was welcomed, and thanks given to the selection committee of Deborah, Randy and Heather.
- A meeting of the Central Experimental Farm Advisory Council (CEFAC) is scheduled to discuss a revised Management Plan for the Farm and the proposed Bill C-23 to protect heritage properties.
- A walkabout is scheduled with new AAFC manager Melanie Houle to highlight successes and possible future projects.
- A break-in to Building 72 occurred, fortunately with no losses to AAFC or the Friends. The need to lock doors was emphasized.

## TREASURER'S REPORT/FINANCIAL ISSUES - Randy

- Randy reviewed the financial position as of the end of October. Both the bank balance and the Safeguard the Future fund were down slightly in the balance sheet. In the income statement, low revenues for reasons such as the terminated donor bench program and reduced number of events was a concern.
- After discussion, it was decided that the price of the jigsaw puzzles was too high to be competitive and generate sales. The price will be reduced to \$29.99 in time for Christmas.
- A few inputs are still required for the 2023 budget.

A committee has begun meeting with a tentative goal to roll out the program next Spring. A program description and budget is being prepared for discussion.

Work is ongoing.

Trees have been selected and a quote for design work is being prepared. Target date for publication is Spring 2024.

- Plant labelling: Dianne. Potential new project to assist AAFC.
- Botanical art booklet: Blaine. Potential new project.

- There was further discussion of Board positions, their scope and responsibility. A decision on filling the role of Vice-President will be made at the next meeting. A new Operations Director has yet to be found.
- Donna is to circulate job descriptions to Board members for update and help in clarifying the scope and responsibility of positions.
- Deborah reported that an expert volunteer, Mark Vigder, has joined us to provide help with technical issues.
- Donna will look into acquiring new first aid kits for garden volunteers.
